Designation of the University of Chicago Sites for Remedial Action Under the Formerly Utilized MED/AEC Sites Remedial Action Project (FUSRAP)

Based on the data in the attached reports, it has been determined that the sites noted at the University of Chicago are contaminated with radioactive residues as a result of MED/AEC operations at these sites. The contamination is in excess of acceptable guidelines and warrants designation for remedial action under FUSRAP.

I am attaching five copies each of the following radiological survey reports:

1. "Radiological Survey of Ryerson Physical Laboratory, University of Chicago," Sept. 11, 1976 (DOE/EV-0005/23).
2. "Radiological Survey of Eckhart Hall, University of Chicago," March 1977 (DOE/EV-0005/24).
3. "Radiological Survey of Herbert Jones Chemical Laboratory, University of Chicago," June 1977 (DOE/EV-0005/26).

The Kent Chemical Laboratory, University of Chicago, has been decontaminated by the University staff and, if warranted, will be certified by this office; therefore, there is no action necessary by the Technical Services Division, Oak Ridge Operations Office (TSD/OR). The decontamination of the Kent Laboratory was performed in a cost-effective manner by the University. I encourage you to work with the University to achieve a cost-effective cleanup of the three other locations which are designated above.

The West Stands, New Chemistry Laboratory and Annex and the Recketts Laboratory, University of Chicago, have no residual radioactive material attributable to MED/AEC activities in excess of the acceptable standards; therefore, these sites are not being designated for remedial action, and no action is necessary by TSD/OR.

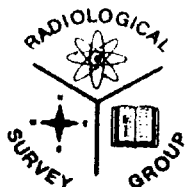
