Former C-B Tool Products Co. 956 E. 58th Street Chicago, Illinois

The University of Chicago Ingleside Hall is located at this address. It is the University Office of Employment and contains a U.S. Post Office. The structure is several stories and looks like it may have existed in the 1940's. The building is West of the Ellis-58th intersection and is on 58th where it dead-ends into the West side of the University Hospital area (see Figure 1).

The University will be contacted to determine if the building could have been the site of the C-B Tool operation.

Former ERA Tool and Engineering Co. 4555 W. Addison Street Chicago, Illinois

This address is presently the site of Audio-Tex Industries, Inc., (phone 725-881). It appears that the structure is single story and appears that it could have been in existence at the time of the ERA Tool work. The structure is on W. Addison, east of Knox Street and is shown on Figure 2. It is just before the railroad tracks.

The next step is to call the owner.

R. Krasberg & Sons Manufacturing Co. 2501 West Homer Street Chicago, Illinois

The building is occupied by the Trade Finishing Services, Incorporated, and is located east of Rockwell Street. The structure is single story and made of light brown brick. It looks relatively new and has either been built since the time of the MED work or has been drastically renovated. The phone number is 252-4900.

The next step is to contact the owner.

William E. Pratt Manufacturing Co. 18 Henderson Avenue Joliet, Illinois

> The facility is now occupied by Altrachem, Inc., phone number 726-8659. The structure is multi-story (high bay) and is in fairly poor condition, but it appears a portion of it is used for office space. No map of Joliet was obtained; however, the facility is reached by heading south into Joliet on Route 171 (Collins Street) and turning east on Route 6, Henderson is off of Route 6 (right turn onto Henderson).

The next step is to call the owner.

Vapofier Corporation 11957 Vincennes Avenue Blue Island, Illinois

Time did not permit the identification of this site. However, ANL will be requested to drive by the address to see if they can identify the current status of the property and the occupant.
