From February 1944 to May 1944, I was employed by Columbia University, Division of War Research. This was a part of the secret MED operation in New York City.

The Pupin Laboratory on campus was the headquarters for the operation but actual operations were carried out at the so-called Nash Building on Broadway above 125th Street.

We were working on a pilot plant, gaseous diffusion barriers appeared from time to time, and a certain section was involved in work on Process Gas.

I have never seen this facility listed as one that has been checked out for possible residual contamination. Therefore, I am calling it to your attention, in accordance with the June 1, 1978, information announcement.
