Dear Mr. Iannizzara:

At the request of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and with your company's consent, Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) performed a radiological survey of the Copperweld Steel Company facility in Warren, Ohio. I am enclosing a copy of the ORNL report, entitled <a href="Preliminary Site Survey Report of the Copperweld Steel Company">Preliminary Site Survey Report of the Copperweld Steel Company</a>, 4000 Mahoning Avenue, NW, Warren, Ohio (CWOOO1). This report has also been furnished to the United Steelworkers of America (Local 2243), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the State of Ohio for their use.

The survey found that the radiation levels and measured radioactivity are not significantly different from normal background levels in Ohio. Since no radioactivity relating to DOE's predecessor was found during the survey, DOE will eliminate your company's facility from further consideration in its Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP).
