Notification of Need for Some Form of Remedial Action - E.I. Dupont DeNemours and Co., Deepwater, New Jersey

EV/ECT has determined a portion of the E.I. Dupont DeNemours and Co. facility at Deepwater, New Jersey to be contaminated with radioactive residue as a result of activities conducted for the Manhattan Engineer District and Atomic Energy Commission. We consider this site low priority as it is under control of the E.I. Dupont Co. and not accessible to the general public. Enclosed in support of these findings are:

- The radiological survey report for the E.I. Dupont DeNemours and Co. facility, and
- The E.I. Dupont DeNemours and Co. facility Site Summary.

The Office of General Counsel has made a preliminary determination that DOE has sufficient authority to pursue remedial measures at this site. In addition, Dupont personnel have indicated some interest in conducting the required remedial action at this facility. We recommend you consider this alternative when evaluating possible remedial action options.

Please keep us informed of the status of this project in order that EV may fulfill our overview responsibility for FUSRAP.
