

Dear Mr. Faust:

On August 25, 1977, three members of the Bureau of Radiation Protection performed a radiation survey of certain areas of Palmer Laboratory. The hallways of the basement floor and rooms 115 through 132 exclusive of the storage room were surveyed for fixed beta-gamma activity. The trenches in room 122 were also surveyed. Three areas were found to have activity above your established limits of 1000 dpm per 100 cm². These areas were located in the foyer near the loading dock. A follow-up survey performed on Aug. 29 showed the contamination was removed in these areas and the activity levels were below 1000 dpm per 100 cm².
