This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. Kinneman of this office on February 11, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License No. SMB-353 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Kinneman with Mr. Goodrow and Mr. Clatta of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between yourself and Mr. Kinneman on February 19, 1980.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a review of the decontamination of the drains in the basement of Building 7 and the loading dock near Building 7. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

In addition, the inspector made direct radiation readings in various areas and drains in the basement of Building 7 and in the area where the loading dock had been near Building 7. The basic purpose of these measurements was to verify the surveys which your contractor had made following decontamination of portions of your facility. Our measurements indicated higher radiation levels than documented in your contractor's report. From discussions conducted during the inspection we understand that you plan to review these results with your contractor, resurvey where applicable, and contact this office regarding the results of your resurveys. We will review this matter during the next inspection of your licensed program.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.
