SUBJECT: Authorization for Remedial Action at B&T Metals Facility, Columbus, Ohio

TO: Manager, DOE Oak Ridge Field Office

This is to notify you that the B&T Metals facility in Columbus, Ohio, is designated for remedial action under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). This notification does not constitute a FUSRAP baseline change control approval. Approval of the baseline change will be accomplished through the normal baseline change control procedures.

The site was used by the former Manhattan Engineer District for the extrusion and shaping of uranium metal during the 1940s. A radiological survey found residual uranium inside one building and small amounts of residual uranium in soil outside the building. Because of the limited extent of the contamination, the site may be remediated using the expedited cleanup process now under development.
