Dear General Holesinger:

I am enclosing a copy of the radiological survey report for the National Guard Armory, Chicago, Illinois. Although the data noted in the report indicate levels of radioactivity in excess of current guidelines, the radioactive residues presently there do not pose a health hazard provided they were not disturbed in the past and will not be disturbed in the future; i.e., no excavation, building, or construction that would disturb the areas in which contamination was found.

Based on these data and on an authority record review, the National Guard Armory property is being authorized for remedial action and will be included in the remedial action plans of the Department of Energy's Oak Ridge Office (DOE/ORO), the office responsible for implementing remedial action. You, or your representative will be contacted by someone from the DOE/ORO prior to any remedial action activities at the National Guard Armory, Chicago, Illinois, property.
