The Combustion Engineering facility in Windsor, Connecticut, is designated for remedial action under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). This designation is based on the results of a radiological survey, conclusions from an authority review, and a Designation Summary, copies of which are attached.

The site has been assigned a low priority under the FUSRAP protocol. Based on the survey results, the property contains residual radioactive contaminants in concentrations that exceed current guidelines. However, under present use conditions, the contamination does not present a significant health risk to individuals who access the area.

This site has also been used by its owner for a wide range of commercial nuclear activities, none of which, however, involved high-enriched uranium (HEU). The designation of this site does not include areas affected by these commercial nuclear activities. Instead, the designation is restricted to those areas that were affected by AEC contractual activities involving HEU and for which the Department has authority to conduct remedial action under FUSRAP. Additional information concerning this issue may be found in the authority review.

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

TO: Manager, Oak Ridge Operations Office

This is to notify you that the Combustion Engineering Site in Windsor, Connecticut, is designated for remedial action under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). This notification does not constitute a FUSRAP baseline change control approval. Approval of the baseline change will be accomplished through the normal baseline change control procedures.

The site was used by the former Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) for research, development, and production of high-enriched (i.e., enriched to more than 20 percent in the isotope U-235) uranium fuel. A radiological survey found residual high-enriched uranium within the buildings, inside some sewer lines, in a drum burial area, and in portions of the surrounding soil.

This site has also been used by its owner for a wide range of commercial nuclear activities, none of which, however, involved high-enriched uranium (HEU). The designation of this site does not include areas affected by these commercial nuclear activities. Instead, the designation is restricted to those areas that were affected by AEC contractual activities involving HEU and for which the Department has authority to conduct remedial action under FUSRAP.
