The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the Maxey Flats Disposal Site Final Closure Period Remedial Action Construction Report dated April 2018. The report summarized remedial action work performed for final closure of the disposal site. The purpose of this letter is to approve the report.

Following this report, monitoring of surface water and groundwater will continue during the Institutional Control Period for 100 years. Operation and Maintenance of the cover system, the support facilities, and the surface water drainage system will continue indefinitely. Four five-year reviews of the remedy have been performed to date, and the fifth five-year review of the remedy is scheduled for completion in September 2022.
