After our phone conference between all the plants and Peggy Hanson, I discussed the plan of Ms. Hanson to limit the planning level to 10% over target (constrained) levels in the submission, with Alan Jones. As a result of my conversation a formal memo is being prepared. This direction should serve in the interim.

- 1. The submission is due at DAO, (in the hands of your appropriate program manager NOT "in the mail") at NOON April 13, 1993 in order to make the new AL deadline of April 14, 1993. If you can't find your program manager give it to another one (eg Tim Frazier, Sam Cheng, and Art Kleinrath are interchangeable for delivery purposes). This is neccessary to meet the deadline.
- 2. The Planning level dollars in the table of expenditures, should be the REQUIREMENTS case NOT the 110% of target case dollars.
- 3. The Planning Level narrative will have two sections, one for 110% of target level and another for "full compliance" or requirements case.
- 4. The Planning Level narrative section should have a description of the case for the 110% of target level of funding. This section can be short (1 or 2 paragraphs).
- 5. The remainder of the planning level narrative section should be for the full (requirements) case of funding [which is what you should have currently written].
- 6. These two planning level narrative sections should be clearly identified by introductory sentences and subtitles as to which "planning level" they are. The order that the two different planning level narratives appear in should be consistent among ADSs of each program but not necessarily between programs

Following these procedures will ensure that Mound requests sufficient funds in ER and WM. It will put the onus on AL to request sufficient funds Distribution:
