The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Legacy Management invites you to remember the work that took the Fernald Feed Materials Production Center to the Fernald Closure Project to the Fernald Preserve. At the time, the project was one of the largest environmental cleanup operations ever undertaken in the history of the United States.

See how the site has come full circle with the restoration of extensive natural habitats including wetland, prairies, and forest.

Enjoy walks, demonstrations, special guests, and refreshments as we contemplate the dramatic changes that have been brought about on the landscape. You will have the opportunity to learn about the ongoing aquifer remediation, monitoring programs, and the community asset features including walking trails, wildlife viewing, history exhibits, and meeting spaces.

The mission changed from broad scale environmental remediation to groundwater remedy, ecological restoration, monitoring, and public access during October of 2006. See the land now—10 years later.
