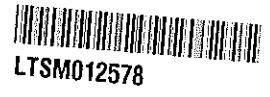

Dear Mr. Rozanski:

I have enclosed a copy of the Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, & Proposed Plan, which was developed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District, for the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) former Bliss & Laughlin Site. This document was released for public comment on September 28, 1998. The comment period currently extends through October 28, 1998.

The preferred cleanup alternative for the former Bliss & Laughlin Site is decontamination of the building, which is identified as Alternative No. 3, and explained on Page 21 of the Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, & Proposed Plan. This alternative presents no unacceptable risk to either workers or the general public, and can be implemented in a timely and cost effective manner.
