
Dear Mr. Moore:

The New York State Department of Health staff reviewed the United States Army Corps of Engineer's (US ACE) revised May 2014 Remedial Investigation work plan for the Indoor Dust Sampling Plan for the former NL Industries Colonie FUSRAP site in the Town of Colonie, Albany County. Overall, we find the sampling rationale, methods and procedures to be acceptable. While the work plan lacks project specific actions or cleanup goals, I understand that the US ACE are in the process of developing such action goals/guidelines to be used in the decision making process once all sampling results are finalized.

Given this information, I find the work plan acceptable, provided we are able to work cooperatively with the US ACE in developing these goals and are in agreement that final cleanup goals to be used at this site are protective of human health.
