This letter is in reply to your December 5, 2006 letter requesting a status report on the subject project.


Since August 2002, the Corps of Engineers completed a comprehensive Remedial Investigation and Risk Assessment (RI/RA) Report in April 2004. Subsequently, the Corps conducted an extensive evaluation of what constitutes the “Designation” under FUSRAP at the request of Combustion Engineering (CE). The evaluation resulted in the Corps considering some additional chemicals as FUSRAP related, to err on the side of protecting human health and the environment.

Concurrent to the evaluation of the site “Designation”, the Corps has been actively engaged in completing the Feasibility Study (FS) for the project. At this time, we require additional data to complete the FS and are in discussions with CE over how best to acquire the information. It is our plan to have the information early in 2007.

Upon completion of the supplemental sampling, the Corps will complete and issue the FS, followed by a Proposed Plan (PP). We anticipate active participation by the Town of Windsor in the preparation and review of the Proposed Plan in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) process. It is our hope that the PP will be released mid year.
