
This is in response to your verbal request of several weeks ago for information on the Linde FUSRAP project. Previously you were provided a table entitled "Summary of Concentration Range for Radiological Isotopes in the Soil Stored in Building 30." Enclosed as you requested, are more detailed analytical data on the Building 30 soil pile, entitled "Sampling Results from Soil Piles Stored in Linde - Building 30."

Also enclosed, at your request, is a copy of the document "Results of the Radiological Survey at the Town of Tonawanda Landfill, Tonawanda, New York (TNY001)" prepared by the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. This document provides the basis for the designation of the Town of Tonawanda Landfill as a vicinity property to the Linde FUSRAP site.
