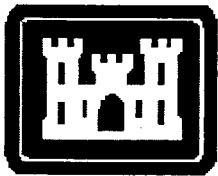

SUBJECT: US EPA Region V Involvement with the Madison FUSRAP Site

To answer questions and concerns from you and USACE HQ personnel concerning involvement of US EPA Region V in the CERCLA process for the Madison FUSRAP Site, I am preparing this memorandum for the record. The memorandum will serve as official documentation of EPA Region V's involvement and should be entered into the Administrative Record for the Madison Site.

The EPA Region V point of contact for the Madison Site is Mr. Ken Tyndall, Chief of the Federal Facilities Response Section. Mr. Tyndall was provided an official copy of the RI/FS/PP for the Madison Site on January 31, 2000 – the start of the public response period. Mr Tyndall was contacted at the end of the public response period and he verbally indicated that his office would not be providing any comments on the documents.

At 1340 today (May 18, 2000), I spoke with Mr Tyndall again to reaffirm that US EPA Region V has not reviewed the FS/PP and would not be providing any comments concerning the selected remedy for the Madison Site. Mr Tyndall stated that since his office receives no resources to oversee the FUSRAP sites and because the site is not on the NPL, Region V defers to the State for all review and comment. As you recall, Illinois EPA (IEPA) deferred to the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety (IDNS) on the Madison Site since it involved radioactive material.

US EPA Region V has not and does not intend to review or comment on the Madison FUSRAP Site RI/FS/PP.
