Investigations of the Painesville Site have found the soil to be contaminated with uranium, radium and thorium, resulting from activities of the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) in the early years of the United States' atomic energy and weapons program. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) recently completed a Feasibility Study for the site, which developed and evaluated alternatives to address the contamination. The Proposed Plan identifies the preferred alternative for cleanup of the site, which is Excavation and Off-site Disposal for radiologically contaminated soils associated with past Federal government activities.
