

Investigations of the Painesville Site have found uranium, radium and thorium contamination in the soil, resulting from past activities of the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) in the early years of the United States' atomic energy and weapons program. After consideration of comments received during the 30-day public review period of the Proposed Plan, released in July 2005, the Corps of Engineers has chosen Excavation and Off-site Disposal of radiologically contaminated soils as the Selected Remedy for the Painesville Site. All of the comments received during the public comment period, and the responses to them, are included in the Responsiveness Summary portion of the Record of Decision.

The cleanup of the Painesville Site detailed in the Record of Decision is scheduled to begin the summer of 2006, and be completed in 2007. 


