Subject: New Rocky Flats Site Contact Record Available

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Legacy Management (LM) posted the Rocky Flats Site, Colorado, Contact Record 2022-01 for the North Walnut Creek Slump exploratory test pits.

This contact record describes DOE's proposal to conduct subsurface investigations in the Solar Ponds Plume Treatment Systems (SPPTS) and the North Walnut Creek Slump area at the Rocky Flats Site. The activity is to better understand factors contributing to the hillside's instability.

The contact record was approved by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) in coordination with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 8.
