The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Legacy Management's Rocky Flats Site, Colorado, posted contact records CR 2025-01 and CR 2025-03.

<u>Contact Record 2025-01</u> reviews a reportable condition at Point of Evaluation GS10 for a 12-month rolling average concentration for uranium that exceeds the applicable Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) standard.

<u>Contact Record 2025-03</u> documents the RFLMA parties' agreement to a minor modification of the Original Landfill (OLF) Monitoring and Maintenance Plan, which will reduce the OLF inspection frequency from monthly to quarterly.

The contact records were approved by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment in coordination with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 8.
