Dear Mr. Murl:

By email dated July 31, 2018, Weiss Associates on behalf of the Department of Energy (DOE) submitted the Addendum to the First Five-Year Review (First FYR) and the attached Vapor Intrusion Evaluation Report (VIER), (collectively, Addendum), prepared for the Energy-Related Health Research Federal Facility (Site) at the University of California, Davis (UC Davis). The Addendum was submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB), and the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC, collectively, Regulatory Agencies) for review. The Addendum was prepared to update the First FYR for the DOE Areas at the Site, since the FYR could not contain a protectiveness statement for the DOE Areas due to unevaluated vapor intrusion concerns.

DTSC previously reviewed and approved the draft final VIER on June 11, 2018. The final version of the VIER was submitted the Regulatory Agencies July 2018, and DTSC verified that any changes from the draft final to final VIER were reasonable, and not of concern to DTSC.

DTSC finds the VIER accurately supports the Addendum, and agrees with the new protectiveness statement contained within the Addendum that "The Remedy at the DOE Areas of LEHR is protective of human health and the environment."

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DTSC hereby approves the Addendum. Please submit a physical copy of the Addendum with wet signature to DTSC for the LEHR administrative record.
