The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is in receipt of the Draft Final Post-Remedial Action Report (Draft Final PRAR) for the Wayne Interim Storage Site dated September 2003.

As expressed in our April 23, 2003 letter regarding the Draft PRAR, the post-excavation soil data complies with the ARARs identified in the Record of Decision. The data also complies with the New Jersey Soil Remediation Standards for Radioactive Materials, N.J.A.C. 7:28-12 et. seq., although these were not identified as ARARs in the Record of Decision.

Upon review, the Draft Final PRAR appropriately addresses the editorial comments the NJDEP provided in its April 23, 2003 letter, and is therefore acceptable.

We look forward to receiving the Final PRAR and moving one step closer to completing the remediation the Wayne Interim Storage Site. NJDEP wishes to congratulate the USACE and its contractors for a job well done.
