Reference is made to your memorandum of July 14, 1950, to this office, concerning a quantity of impure black oxide (MX-308) for sale by Linde. Under its domestic uranium program, the Commission has undertaken to purchase refined uranium products at a price of \$3.50 per pound of contained U₃O₈ (avoirdupois dry weight) f.o.b. shipping point. The quantity referred to is less than the minimum quantity specified. However, subject to mutual agreement upon the terms of a purchase contract, the Commission offers to purchase the impure U₃O₈ at a price not to exceed \$3.50 per pound of contained U₃O₈ f.o.b. Linde's plant. As in previous purchases, the payment will be based on the U₃O₈ content as determined by Government sampling and assaying.

If Linde is interested in selling on these terms, we shall proceed to draw up a purchase contract upon receipt of word from you.
