Wright Air Development Center Air Research and Development Command Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio	C-3547 C-3407 C-3393 C-3331 SNM-62	Issued at least three source material licenses and one special nuclear material license covering the period 8/15/55 8/1/57 for 3 1/2# of uranium metal discs for use in beta calibration; 200 grams of normal or NS-40 grade uranium metal for use as uranium sorption beds; and 50# of refined source material (about 4# of uranium depleted in the isotope U-235. License No. C-3331 was apparently for 250# of F-3 material.
