UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA

On January 17, 1978, Edward J. Jascewsky, Department of Energy (DOE), and Walter H. Smith, Argonne National Laboratory (ANL), visited the University of Arizona. The purpose of the visit was to discuss the past operations of certain facilities that were previously used by the Bureau of Mines for the Atomic Energy Commission work. Enclosed are three drawings showing the location of these facilities. The Bureau of Mines activities have been closed down for about fifteen years, and the property of concern is now owned by the University of Arizona. Discussions were held with Dr. Triffet, Dean, College of Engineering, and Mr. Carl Irwin, Health Physicist.

Discussion with Dr. Irwin established that these facilities are no longer involved with any radioactive operations. They are basically office areas and a storage warehouse.

A cursory survey of the facility was performed by Messrs. Jascewsky and Smith. The instruments used were an Eberline gas proportional counter (PAC-4G-3) and an Eberline end window geiger-mueller detector (Model E-530). The survey included a representative sampling of the floor and wall areas. No radioactivity levels above background were found.






